

Did You Know About the Terrell Hills Police Department Civilian Observer Program?



The Civilian Observer program is a valuable education tool for students and citizens wishing to learn about duties relating to the law enforcement profession. Once approved to participate, the observer may ride along with one of our officers as they patrol the city. We encourage residents of Terrell Hills to participate in the program and get to know your police officers. Upon completing your ride along, you will receive a complimentary t-shirt.

The requirements for this program are as follows:

- The civilian observer release form must be filled out
- The observer must be 18 years of age
- A criminal history check must be done on an observer
- The observer must have no arrest record
- The appearance of the observer must be neat and clean
